World Water Day 2020: Water and Climate Change

1 World Water Day is observed annually on March 22 to raise awareness about the vital importance of water to safeguarding human security and maintaining the health of the planet's ecosystems. This year's theme, "Water and Climate Change," highlights the urgent importance of strengthening water security and establishing access to a sustainable water supply in the face of changing climate conditions worldwide.

5 Increasing sustainable access to safe drinking water is a key objective, which seeks to provide 15 million people with sustainable access to drinking water services by 2022. Globally, 663 million people still lack access to safe drinking water sources living in conflict-affected states with poor governance, insecure tenure, high rates of poverty, and weak institutions which have deteriorated the condition of water supply services.

10 Access to a safe and reliable drinking water source is critical for health and livelihoods, and is especially important for unlocking educational and economic opportunities for women and girls. The reliable provision and management of drinking water also builds trust in local and national governments, and can contribute to local and national stability.

15 The main aims of these projects focus their attention on increasing access levels, attention to services and utilities and investments in water supply will continue. Thanks to the impact of these programs, communities around the world are benefiting from access to improve water and sanitation services and becoming more resilient in the face of a changing climate.
