

# Culture workshop on Malta

## Teaching Guide

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**AGE GROUP:** 10 to 14 years old.

### **INTRODUCTION**

Knowledge of European heritage, both tangible and intangible, as well as the richness and cultural diversity of the different countries that make up the European Union, is essential for our students to understand the importance of belonging to it. Likewise, this knowledge will help us to promote in our students values such as tolerance, solidarity and respect for the different existing cultural expressions, as well as to know the pluralism typical of a democratic society. For this reason, we have developed a Work Unit with which we intend to bring this heritage closer to the classrooms. In this case, we will work on Malta.

### **OBJECTIVES**

- Know the geography of Malta.
- Bringing students closer to the cultural and historical heritage of Malta.
- Learn about some of the customs and traditions of the Maltese culture.
- Raise awareness about the importance of respect for cultural diversity.
- Promote values such as tolerance, respect and solidarity.
- Understand relevant historical facts.

### **PROFICIENCIES**

This work unit is designed with integrated activities that allow students to advance in the development of the following skills:

- Linguistic communication.
- Digital.
- Social and civic competence.
- Consciousness and cultural expressions.
- Learn to learn.

### **TIMING**

The development of this work unit consists of 2 sessions of 45 minutes.

#### **Introduction (5 minutes)**

“Brainstorming” about Malta. We will ask students to list things they know about Malta and Maltese culture. We can encourage them to talk about the names of islands, cities, food, traditions, sports or any topic that is familiar to them and that relates to that country.

#### **Development (25 minutes)**

We will reproduce the interactive presentation.

#### **Evaluation (15 minutes)**

We will check the level of understanding of our students through the interactive games proposed in the final part of the presentation.

### **MATERIALS**

- Interactive presentation.

### **RECOMMENDATIONS**

- Different interactive elements appear in the presentation that must be clicked in order to see the information, videos, photos, etc., hidden behind them. These icons are "pulsing" to be easily identified.
- It is recommended to discover the information by following the numbers consecutively.
- Subtitle mode can be activated for all videos for better understanding. As well as there is the option to choose the language of said subtitles. (To activate them there is an adjustment wheel in the lower right corner of the window).
